GOLDEN CIRCLE SELF DRIVE

**8 Days from Anchorage
Daily (except Monday)**

• Day 1 Anchorage

Arrive in Anchorage on your own and pick up your mid-size rental car. The remainder of day is free to explore Alaska's largest city.

• Day 2 Anchorage / Whittier / Valdez

Today you drive 65 miles to the town of Whittier. There you board the Alaska State ferry, sailing across Prince William Sound past Columbia Glacier to Valdez.

• Day 3 Valdez to Paxson Area

Explore Valdez this morning and then depart for the 190-mile drive over the scenic Richardson Highway to Paxson on the Denali Highway. You overnight in the Paxson area.

• Day 4 Paxson to Denali Park

Today's drive will cover 145 miles over the scenic Denali Highway to Cantwell and on to Denali National Park for your overnight stay.

• Day 5 Customize your Denali National Park Experience

Today is yours to schedule your personal exploration of the Park. Please see Page 4 for all the possible tour options available to customize your stay in the Park.

• Day 6 Denali to Talkeetna

Travel 153 miles over the George Parks Highway. Look for great views of Mt. McKinley enroute. Talkeetna is the starting point for climbers of Mt. McKinley. Enjoy an afternoon Jetboat Safari tour.

• Day 7 Talkeetna to Anchorage

It's 115 miles to Anchorage, passing through the famous Mat-Su Valley farming area. Or take a side trip over scenic Hatcher Pass and visit the Independence Mine State Historical Park.

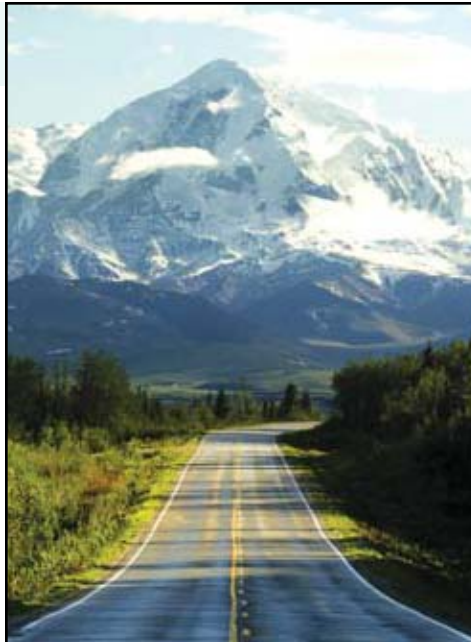
• Day 8 Anchorage

Drop your car at the airport where all arrangements end.

• Day 1 Anchorage

Arrive in Anchorage on your own and pick-up your mid-size car and begin your exploration.

• Day 2 Anchorage to Talkeetna

Drive 115 miles to Talkeetna. Plan to arrive in the early afternoon in time for a thrilling Jetboat Safari on the Susitna River.

• Day 3 Talkeetna to Denali Park

Today's trip covers 150 miles to Denali. Watch for great views of Mt. McKinley, along the way.

• Day 4 Customize your Denali National Park Experience

Today is yours to schedule your personal exploration of the Park. Please see Page 4 for all the possible tour options available to customize your stay in the Park.

• Day 5 Denali Park to Fairbanks

There is plenty of time for more Park activities, as today you drive only 125 miles to Fairbanks over the George Parks Highway. This evening enjoy the Alaska Salmon Bake (included). (D)

• Day 6 Fairbanks Sightseeing

This morning you may want to drive to the El Dorado Gold Camp to look at the mining history. Your tour this afternoon is aboard the sternwheeler Riverboat Discovery. Included is a stop at an Indian village and a sled dog demonstration.

• Day 7 Fairbanks

Tour ends upon returning your vehicle to the Fairbanks airport.

WRANGELL- ST. ELIAS NATIONAL PARK

• Day 1 Anchorage

Arrive Anchorage using your own arrangements and pick up a mid-size car with unlimited mileage.

• Day 2 Anchorage to Denali Park

Enjoy the 236-mile drive today through the Mat-Su Valley. Continue past the town of Wasilla and over Hurricane Gulch to Denali National Park.

• Day 3 Customize your Denali National Park Experience

Today is yours to schedule your personal exploration of the Park. Please see Page 4 for all the possible tour options available to customize your stay in the Park.

• Day 4 Denali Park to Paxson

Today you travel 145 miles over the picturesque Denali Highway to Paxson. Keep a lookout for Mt. McKinley and wildlife as you travel this highway.

• Day 5 Paxson to Wrangell- St. Elias National Park

Today's trip takes you 215 miles over the Richardson and Edgerton Highways to the old town of Chitina. Enjoy this town on the edge of the Wrangell-St. Elias National Park

• Day 6 Wrangell-St. Elias Park Sightseeing

Today enjoy a full day tour of the Park. You depart by coach this morning and enjoy views of the glacier, the old Kennicott Mine and then return by air to enjoy a vista of one of our great National Parks.

• Day 7 Wrangell-St. Elias to Valdez

Depart on your 175-mile drive to Valdez, known as the "Switzerland of Alaska" because of its picturesque setting.

• Day 8 Valdez to Whittier / Seward

Board your car on the Alaska State ferry sailing across Prince William Sound past Columbia Glacier to the port of Whittier. Continue your trip, driving 95 miles to the seaport of Seward.

• Day 9 Seward to Girdwood

Depart on your morning tour to Kenai Fjords National Park. Today your drive is about 90 miles to Girdwood. Sights along the way include Moose Pass, Summit Lake and Portage Glacier.

• Day 10 Girdwood to Anchorage

It's a short 40 miles to Anchorage on the Seward Highway. Travel along scenic Turnagain Arm and past Potters Marsh, where arrangements end upon return of your rental vehicle.
