

ABOVE THE ARCTIC CIRCLE



DAY IN NOME

1-Day **Daily**
May 22 – Sep 8

From Anchorage \$475 + \$25 tax
From Fairbanks \$725 + \$45 tax
From ANC to FAI (or rev) \$600 + \$35 tax

You'll depart Anchorage in the morning to Nome. Upon arrival in Nome, your guide will give a brief orientation and outline of your visit to Nome and how the gold rush shaped this frontier town.

Visit a dog musher's camp, where you'll see a sled dog team in action and learn about the training and care of dog teams. Depart in the late afternoon for Anchorage on Alaska Airlines.

ARCTIC CIRCLE FLY / DRIVE

1 Day
From Fairbanks

Jun 1 - Sep 1 **\$319+ \$20 tax**

Depart Fairbanks by air for your flight across the Arctic Circle to Prospect Creek and receive an official Arctic Circle Adventure Certificate. Upon arrival, you will be met by a representative and then commence your return journey by van to Fairbanks via the famed Dalton Highway.

A stop is made at the Yukon River and a visit to the Arctic Circle Trading Post, located in the rural community of Joy, Alaska. Arrive back in Fairbanks under the light of the Midnight Sun.

BUSH MAIL PLANE TOUR

4 hours **Daily**
(except Saturdays)
From Fairbanks

May 15 - Sep 20 **\$299 + \$10 tax**

There are no roads to the Alaska Bush so getting there starts at Warbelow's Air in Fairbanks...flying Interior airways since 1959. This tour will fly you to 3-5 villages and take you over some of the most spectacular scenery. Your time is limited in the villages but you will have time to stretch your legs and partake in one of the great legends of the delivering the mail to rural communities.

BARROW EXPEDITION

Day **Daily**
From Fairbanks

May 16 - Sep 18 **\$579 + \$20 tax**

For those that want a more in depth Arctic experience our expedition trip is for you. Depart Fairbanks and flightsee over the Arctic Plain to Barrow.

Our schedule is flightseeing and so if the pilot sees caribou, musk ox or other animals a detour is made. Your tour of Barrow is an intimate tour which includes the Inupiat Museum. You return to Fairbanks, flightseeing over the Arctic Plain.

BARROW

1-Day **Daily**
May 13 - Sep 15

From Fairbanks \$475 + \$25 tax
From Anchorage \$725 + \$45 tax
From FAI to ANC (or rev) \$600 + \$35 tax

Jet across the Arctic Circle to Barrow, the "Top of the World", for a glimpse of the Eskimos' fascinating lifestyle. They keep their culture alive by crafting skins, ivory and whalebone in the traditional manner.

Join in a genuine Eskimo demonstration and celebrate the heritage of their legendary ceremonial dances. You will receive a commemorative certificate for crossing the Arctic Circle.



ARCTIC OCEAN ADVENTURE

6 Days from Fairbanks
Daily (except Monday and Wednesday)

May 31 - Sep 1 **\$1649 + \$69 tax**

• Day 1 Fairbanks

Arrive Fairbanks on your own. The remainder of the day is at leisure.

• Day 2 Fairbanks to Coldfoot

Depart this morning by van over the Dalton Highway to the Yukon River. Cross the Arctic Circle at Milepost 115 and receive an official Arctic Circle certificate.

• Day 3 Coldfoot to Prudhoe Bay

Continue north through the majestic Brooks Range to the famous North Slope of Alaska.

• Day 4 Prudhoe Bay to Barrow

This morning's tour includes the Trans-Alaska pipeline and Pump Station #1. In the afternoon you fly to Barrow where you will check into the hotel and have time for dinner on your own.

• Day 5 Barrow to Fairbanks

A tour of Barrow today includes an Inupiat Eskimo cultural program, mask-making demonstration, games and traditional dance. Return to Fairbanks by jet this evening.

• Day 6 Fairbanks

Tour ends upon check out of your hotel today.
